Holiday Flag Program



The New Hampton Rotary Club invites you to join your neighbors in proudly displaying the American Flag in front of your home or business. For an annual subscription price of \$50.00, we will place a 3-foot x 5-foot American Flag on a 7-foot pole in your front yard. A plastic mount will be installed in the ground just below the surface to hold the flag in place but is low enough to not interfere with regular lawn maintenance. Seeing these flags lined up along the streets in our community is truly an impressive site, so we encourage you to talk to your neighbors and get everyone involved! This service is available to anyone within New Hampton city limits. If you want to support our program but don't live in New Hampton, please consider gifting a flag subscription to a friend, family member, active service member or veteran.
