*Important Information for all New Hampton
City Residents & Business Owners*

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recently revised the Lead-Copper rule and is requiring citywide inventories to be completed for lead service lines by October 16th, 2024. A water service line is the connection between the water distribution pipe (water main in the street or right-of-way) and the water meter in your home or business.

If lead service lines are discovered, you may be eligible to receive funding to have those lines replaced. More information to come regarding replacement of lead service lines.

Please submit a survey for your property, regardless of the age of the structure. **This is mandatory to be completed for the City of New Hampton. Failure to submit, may result in City Staff having to enter your structure at a later date to verify.** Please fill out a separate survey for each property you own within the City of New Hampton.
